

Eibhlín Ní Lionáird, Oifigeach Pleanála Teanga, only started in the job in Sept 2022. She sets out the activities currently underway and future plans


Plean Teanga Mhúscraí

- Working with the schools, promoting the spoken tradition of Irish – several children taking part in Oireachtas na Samhna
- Irish classes for beginners, improvers, woodwork through Irish, Cookery classes through Irish. (all classes will continue in 2023)
- Aerobics through Irish in Béal Átha 'n Ghaorthaidh
- Supporting new musical, Tuairín Dubh, which will ón stage in May 2023.
- Supporting the setting up of a new gym in Naomh Abán,
 Baile Mhúirne
- Developing package of supports for businesses.

Múscraí Heritage Plan

- Holistic report –includes all aspects of our area, industry, heritage, tourism, environment, education, transport, etc..
- Key values: Balanced development no centralisation, each village keeps its own identity, schools, srl..
- Diversity wide range of groups, interests is important and a strength to ensure that there is a place for everyone in our community.
- Our language is our foundation stone.
- We must take control of our own future. No-one is going to do it for us. We must do it for ourselves.
- Model for development. Building a Meitheal based on common interests. For example, in area of food...that all the people in the supply chain from farmers to the shops, hotels come together to see what they can do working hand in hand with each other.

Meitheal Turasóireachta Mhúscraí comprised of local businesses and groups interested in promoting tourism in Gaeltacht Mhúscraí. It also has representatives from Údarás na Gaeltachta, Cork County Council and Fáilte Ireland. It is facilitated by Comharchumann Forbartha Mhúscraí.

Tourism Action Plan

- New Tourism Plan ag Gaeltacht Mhúscraí which was launched in May 2022. This is very good start for Gaeltacht Mhúscraí.
- We have everything, music, culture, Coláiste na Mumhan, etc...but no one knows about it. We need to work on this.
- New opportunity for Gaeltacht Mhúscraí to form part of wider new plan developed for west Cork, which will incorporate Gaeltacht Mhúscraí and also include Kenmare. Néil is the new Joint Chair for this plan.
- Encourage everyone to submit their ideas, no matter how small as to how we can promote the area.
