2 VALUES

MEITHEAL - PRIDE OF PLACE - COMMUNITY SPIRIT - COMMITTED - ENERGETIC

The success of this ambitious action plan will require the enthusiasm and efforts of local communities along with supports from government bodies. The local community is driven to develop and improve their locality. To the fore of all consutlations for this plan was the importance of social interactions and community spirit. Developing and nurturing this social cohesion is a fundamental element underpinning all actions. The implementation of this plan is of particular importance to supporting a strong Gaeltacht community. Culture, history and language are celebrated widely throughout the area and extensive recommendations have been made to support the preservation and development of the spoken language of the area.

It is the clear intention of Comharchumann Forbartha Mhúscraí, in collabouration with Údarás na Gaeltachta, in the preparation of this plan, to achieve the goals set out by the community in this action plan.

Local people are aware of the progress that has been made on the area's plans so far. Questions were raised regarding securing adequate investment and funding to support future actions. In the consultation meetings local communities all focused attention on infrastructure and enterprise, noting that these issues had been raised previously and that it would take significant resouces and commitment to make them happen. The desire would be that there will be a clear implementation process to monitor the work of the 5-year Action Plan. There is no question that State resources and support will be needed for this plan to come to fruition.

It is a necessary element of progressing hte plan that local communities are kept informed of the goals and actions achieved from this plan. Progress and developments are to be reported and published in the upcoming newsletters to show that advancements are being made on the action plan and that the wishes and suggestions of all stakeholders in the area will receive feedback from the input they have made.


3 INTRODUCTION

Three comprehensive plans were published for the Múscraí area; Múscraí Language Plan (2017), Múscraí Heritage Plan (2018), Tourism Action Plan (2022). These plans cover a wide range of topics relating to the preservation, development and improvement of the area. These plans support and complement the work proposed in this 5-Year Action Plan. The co-existing plans all set out worthwhile goals for the future of the Múscraí Gaeltacht as a whole.

The vision of the Language Plan is, '... to boost the use of Irish in the area, with wider support and participation from the public.' (1, http://muscrai.org/an-phleanail-teanga/). Comprehensive recommentations are included adn many of these measures are being implemented by the Language Planning Officer.

Cork County Council with Acadamh Fodhla commissioned the Múscraí Heritage Plan, 2018-2032. The vision for this plan is expressed as: 'Múscraí is an incredibly vibrant place. It is a place where the character of its people and landscape are both intertwined and co-dependent. Change always occurs. The role of this document is to help the people of Múscraí manage that change and protect the core significant aspects of the region in which they live. Ultimately, it is envisaged that this document will help make the Gaeltacht become a better place in which to work, live and visit.'(4, https://www.corkcoco.ie/en/resident/heritage-and-conservation/a-heritage-plan-for-the-muscrai-gaeltacht).

The Tourism Action Plan was commissioned by the Meitheal Turasóireachta, (Tourism Working Group) under the auspices of Comharchumann Forbartha Mhúscraí. It was launched in May 2022. A Tourism Officer was newly appointed as a result of this plan in November 2022. The vision in this plan is concurrent to the other plans which aims that the region '... be developed in a sustainable manner and attract visitors through improved infrastructure and experiences with the overall aim to ensure the region is firstly a great place to live and work and therefore by definition a great place to visit. (2, http://muscrai.org/experience-gaeltacht-mhuscrai/).



Comharchumann Forbartha Mhúscraí, with the support of Údarás na Gaeltachta employed Donncha Ó Duinnín, Réidh na nDóirí to prepare this plan on their behalf. The overarching goal of the Co-op is for all communities living in the area to engage in this plan and for the plan to be a living document that reflects the wishes and priorities of the local area. It is intended that the 5-year action plan will underpin strategic developments going forward. The plan notes the importance of communities becoming self-reliant and coming together to effect change.

Suggestions of the community were collected using a variety of methodologies. The 70 recommentations in this plan come from the 242 ideas proposed by the 81 participants who took part in the process of interviews, public meetings, an online survey, and visits to secondary schools that were part of the preparatory work for the plan. Five public meeting were held in; Réidh na nDóirí, Cúil Aodha, Béal Átha an Ghaorthaidh, Cill na Martra, Baile Mhuirne/Baile Mhic Íre. Committee members of the Coistí Gaoluinne in Coláiste Ghobnatan and Scoil Mhuire we consulted, which provided excellent recommendations. In order to generate public input, a video package was created in which the three existing plans were set out and the progress made in them shared.

The ideas on how the proposals can be progressed and who would be responsible for this progress come from the consultation process in the preparation of the plan.

4 GAELTACHT MHÚSCRAÍ REGION

Múscraí Gaeltacht is located 48km west of Cork City on the border with Kerry. The area is a subset of the Macroom Municipal district. Macroom has been designated as a Gaeltacht service town, where a language planning process will begin soon. ((https://gaelphobal.ie/gaeltacht-towns/maigh-chromtha/?lang=ga). Gaeltacht Mhúscraí has a land area of $255km^2$. According to the 2016 census, the area has a population of 3,785. The largest settlement in the area is the village of Baile Mhic Íre/Baile Mhuirne. The main national road N22 passes through the village. A bypass is expected to open in 2023. Béal Átha an Ghaorthaidh is the second largest village in the region. Other notable areas are Réidh na nDoirí, Cill na Martra and Cúil Aodha. There are naoinraí located around the area, which are run by Comharnaoinraí na Gaeltachta, primary schools along with two secondary schools which are under the direction of the Cork Education and Training Board. All the schools operate through the medium of Irish and work is being done on objectives set out in their Plean Oideachas Gaeltachta. The two secondary schools; Coláiste Ghobnatan, Baile Mhic Íre and Scoil Mhuire, Béal Átha an Ghaorthaidh serve students for the local community aswel as from outside the Gaeltacht area. Registration is accepted, therefore from L1 and L2 primary schools. Thare are five primary schools in the area; Scoil Náisiúnta, Réidh na nDoirí, Scoil Lachtain Naofa, Cill na Martra, Scoil Chúil Aodha/Barr d'Inse, Scoile Abán Naofa, Baile Mhic Íre agus Scoil Fionnbarra, Béál Átha an Ghaorthaidh. Most students from second level education continue to further or third level education.

Gaelic culture is rich and going from strength to strength with funding and time investment by local committees. A fantastic example of this is the Aisling Gheal scheme, which offers Sean-nós singing classes. Local singers teach courses to all ages, promoting local traditional songs and styles.

There is a strong sporting culture in the area including; Cumann Peile Cill na Martra, Cumann Peile Naomh Aban, Cumann Peile Béal Átha an Ghaorthaidh, Reigiún na Gaeltachta, Bolchumann na hÉireann, Peileadóirí an tSuláin, Laochra Óg Hurling Club, various martial arts clubs along with various other sporting clubs. It is necessare to mention Údarás na Gaeltachta when mentioning infrastructure in the community, the sub office of which is located in Baile Mhic Íre.



5 ROLE OF ÚDARÁS NA GAELTACHTA

"The overall objective of Údarás na Gaeltachta is to ensure that Irish remains the main communal language of the Gaeltacht and is passed on to future generations. The Údarás endeavours to achieve that objective by funding and fostering a wide range of enterprise development and job creation initiatives and by supporting strategic language, cultural and community based activities." (Údarás na Gaeltachta website)




Údarás na Gaeltachta has industrial estates and business parks in Baile Mhic Íre/Baile Mhuirne and Béal Átha an Ghaorthaidh, in which their client companies work together and greatly contribute to the development of enterprise and employment in the area. According to the website of Údarás na Gaeltachta, there are 699 people in full-time employment by client projects of Údarás na Gaeltacht in the Múscraí Gaeltacht. Funding is urgently required in Béal Átha an Ghaorthaidh Business park to attract enterprise to the area.

It is relevant to acknowledge the support of Údarás na Gaeltachta in achieving a vibrant area in enterprise, culture and language promotion. Údarás na Gaeltachta has extensive experience and valuable expertise necessary to carry out the recommentations in this document. It would be worth consolidating these supports and welcoming the recognised good practice for the benefit of Múscraí. The objectives of Údarás na Gaeltachta ar set out in their Strategic plan, 2021-2025. The themes of this strategy are; Enable, Strengthen, Sustain. "Encouraging and empowering a younger generation to be leaders for the future is of particular importance in our endeavoures. This can be achieved by developing conducive environments, facilities and skills, in partnership with other stakeholders." (18, Údarás na Gaeltachta, Strategic Plan 2021-2025). The input of young people in the development of this plan was essential and ideas were received from the Coistí Gaoluinne in the two Gaeltacht secondary schools. Their imput for the development of the recommendations in this action plan are relevant and worthwhile and inclusion of young people is deserved.

6 ROLE OF COMHARCHUMANN FORBARTHA MHÚSCRAÍ

Mhúscraí, Grá Mhúscraí, Múscraí Glas, Pobal Mhúscraí. The Co-operative has worked for years supporting businesses and committees, while also promoting development plans for the area. The Co-operative has good communication with state organizations and many of these projects are being developed in partnership with Údarás na Gaeltachta, Roinn na Gaeltacht, Cork County Council and other state departments.

The manager of the co-operative also manages the Gteic, the digital hub co-working space in Béal Átha an Ghaorthaidh, which is where the offices of the comharchumann are also located. It has 18 co-working spaces available and is affilitated to the Connected Hubs as well as the wider Gteiceanna network across the Gaeltachtaí. A campaign, among many others initiatives, is underway to attract and increase business numbers into the Gteic. The hub also supports ditigal transformation initiatives in Gaelacht Mhúscraí, and is working to extend the range of services and business and community supports from the hub as well as support the development of social enterprises.

Guth Múscraí is engaged in language development. The program is managed by the Language Planning committee and there is a full-time Language Planning Officer. The value of the work can be seen throughout the area, as well as the fantastic work that is continuously underway by the enthuiastic Language Planning Officer. Courses and classes are available to local people to strengthen spoken Irish, as well as many other initatives with schools, and local businesses.

A Tourism Plan was published in 2022 under the Grá Múscraí programme and many of the goals have been actioned and some others have already been completed under the direction of the Múscraí Tourism Committee. A fresh new branding was created to promote Gaeltacht Mhúscraí. A Tourism Officer was appointed by the Comharchumann in Novemer 2022, to support the implementation of the Tourism Plan, funded by Údarás na Gaeltachta, with marketing support from Cork County Council.

The Múscraí Glas programme aims to promote sustainable living. It has carried out research on the housing stock in the area and initiatied a pilot Retrofit programme for residential houses in 2020, supported by funding from ESB. This work also included raising awareness, organising workshops and providing clinics on conserving energy and using renewable energy. It also commissioned a Waste Management Plan which will be actioned. A wider focus on sustainable living is being developed which will include Food sustainability and the circular economy.

The Comharchumann, with the programme, Pobal Múscraí, gives help and support in any and every way possible to community groups and voluntary committees that are active in the local area. In addition to assistance given regarding information and access to funding sources, the Comharchumann supports the rural social schemes, the day centres, the youth clubs and social enterprises in the area.

The Comharchumann realises that it has a role to play in the development of the action plan, together with local businesses and the local community. Comharchumann Forbartha Mhuscraí is driven towards assisting in developing, planning, implementing and reporting the recommendations in this action plan for the benefit of the community, the language and spirit of Gaeltacht Mhúscraí.

7 STATE BODIES & THIS PLAN

Recently, strategic plans have been developed in State departments, which will have a positive impact on this action plan. Among the strategic plans is; Our Rural Future, Rural Development Policy 2021-2025 from the Department of Rural and Community Development. On page 7 of this Policy it states, "Our Vision is for a thriving rural Ireland which is integral to our national economic, social, cultural and enviormental wellbeing and development, which is built on the interdependence of urban and rural areas, and which recognises the centrality of people, the importance of vibrant and lived-in rural places, and the potential to create quality jobs and sustain our shared environment."

Cork County Council has prepared the Cork County Development Plan 2022-2028. Cork County Council, together with Researcha and Dig and Acadamh Fódhla have published a heritage plan which will greatly support the implementation of the recommendations in this document with an emphasis on culture and language.

"The continuing use of the Irish language across the Gaeltacht has been a critical factor in the retention of Gaelic tradition in song, poetry, dance, lore and music. Its retention as the primary language must stand as the central aim of any plan concerned with intangible heritage." (52, Muscari Heritage Plan, 2018)

The Mission of Údarás na Gaeltachcta in their Strategic Plan 2021-2025 is " To foster a sustainable Gaeltacht community where Irish is the main language, and where employment, society and culture make a world-class quality of life available."

It seems that there is a positive discourse towards, firstly, the Irish language and, secondly, development of rural areas in the state system. It is clear that there is a distinct value placed on the Múscraí Gaeltacht.













8 AIMS OF THIS ACTION PLAN & HOW TO USE IT

A common pattern of themes emerged from the consultation process. The recommendations were divided into strategic sub-categories that would support their separation for implementation. Different organisations are designated to take responsibility for different proposals. There are seven Target Areas in the action plan;

1)Teanga, Cultúr & na hEalaíona	4) Fiontraíocht, Seirbhísí, & Infreastruchtúr
2)Turasóireacht	5) Seribhísí Oideachais & Oiliúna
3) An Ghaeltacht Ghlas, Fuinneamh Inathnuaite	6) Eispearas Socheolaíochta
	7) Margaíocht

It is expected that the recommendations in this plan will be implemented over a period of five years, depending on different circumstances and needs, related to specific activities. A key timeline has been laid out for this plan which will guide a timetable for all the proposals.

Short-term – That it will be a goal to have the recommendation implemented within a year and a half from the launch of the plan.

Medium Term – That it will be a goal to have the recommendation implemented within three years from the launch of the plan.

Long Term – That it will be a goal to have the recommendation implemented within five years from the launch of the plan.

The main objective of this plan is to develop Múscraí, with the input of the local community, which would make the area better to live, work and visit. The culture and language of this place are the foundation in which we are able to stand on. Opportunities for speaking, learning and improving the Irish language are proposed, which would strengthen the ability and fluency of spoken Irish in the area. It is deserving to acknowledge the community spirit and the enthusiasm shown, from the consultation process, to improve the area. The community is certainly aware and motivated towards development of the area. Voluntary committees are the cornerstone of achieving this plan. No one, no group is better suited to drive the recommendations in this action plan than the local people themselves. There is a role and a place for everyone in the area, to support this action plan, both young and people with long life experience, experience they can and should share with future leaders. The state system is motivated by these improvements, which are reflected in their strategic plans. It is with these supports, local organizations, together with suitable investment, that the vision of the future will flourish for the sake of living, working, well-being and attracting people to visit Gaeltacht Mhúscraí.

FINAL COMMENTS

There is a role and a place for everyone in the area, to support this action plan, both young and people with long life experience, experience they can and should share with future leaders. The state bodies can then get in behind these actions to help them come to fruition. It is with these supports, local organizations, together with suitable investment, that the vision of the future will flourish as a sustainable communit for working, well-being and attracting people to visit Gaeltacht Mhúscraí.

While this plan was being written, the proposals and ideas, discussed at public meeting are being worked on by committees and new leaders are coming to the fore. New committees have been formed and are going from strength to strength organizing and planning.
